
Rainthambore National Park is a vast wildlife reserve in Rajasthan, northern India. Formerly a royal hunting ground for the late Kings of the Chauhan dynasty, the scene is straight out of Kipling's 'Jungle Book'. The ruined temples are overrun by forest, wild animals are in abundance with leopards, monkey, marsh crocodiles and even bear dotting the landscape. However, the real star of Ranthambore is the tiger.

The tiger population is healthy and active, making it almost guaranteed that you will witness one of nature's most rare apex predators. Elusive, highly active, and of such sheer, breathless beauty; the tiger is an animal that inspires both awe and fear.

During your stay at Ranthambore, you can revel in accommodation, service and architecture that can only be described as opulent - in customary Indian style.






amibia is the ultimate contrast to Istanbul. The vast sand dunes are vivid orange with black shadow lines that dissect them with almost geometric precision. The landscape looks more lunar than earthly and yet, somehow, there is still life.

The Namib desert is one of the oldest and driest on Earth with a surprising array of adapted wildlife. We will see giant Oryx antelope standing motionless on the summit of the dunes, their flanks open to the weak desert breeze, trying to cool their bodies.

Up close, the low salt pans look crystal white, with eerie black trees mummified by the lack of moisture. In this intensely barren landscape, the rains come every twenty years or so, creating a bloom of flowers across the entire landscape. The seeds have been waiting all this time for a single drop of rain.




CATAMARAN SAILING



This is the world's most extraordinary day trip! We switch onto our specialist polar plane and fly 5 hours over the mighty Southern Ocean. Soaring past thousands of icebergs, we cross into 24-hours continuous sunshine and onto the last continent – Antarctica!

We spend 4 hours on the ground, experiencing the deep interior of the continent and some of planet Earth's most surreal scenery. Surrounded by 3,000ft pinnacles of rock that rise vertically out of the ice, we do a gentle trek to the summit of 'Birdfall' mountain, followed by a journey to a subterranean cave filled with ice crystals. To finish, we have a glass of champagne in the world's most southerly ice bar!

For those that wish to experience more, there is the option to stay a further 4 days in Antarctica.
